[Martin House - Dining & Sitting Room](#)

Martin House dining room and sitting room are open plan spaces at the very heart of many activities involving the children and families.

Starting at the dining room, our mural is a work in progress which is slowly spreading down the wall of the corridor past the children's bedrooms.
