6th Anniversary

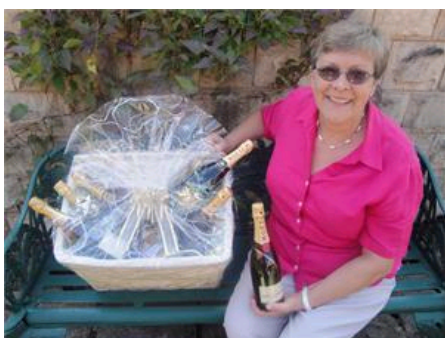

We were delighted that the 'E' shift syndicate from Ferrybridge Power station were the jackpot winners of our fifth anniversary draw.



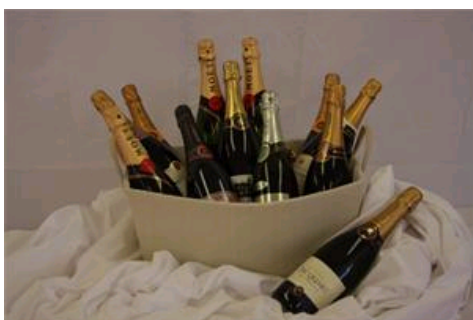
